



RSA NUMBER SPECIFICATIONS

Each model power boater registered with SAMPBA is obliged to display his unique “RSA” number that was allocated to him during registration, on any of his boats during any race event, even when practicing.

This will prove that the boater is legally registered with SAMPBA and that he / she conducts the sport and is committed to the rules and constitution of SAMPBA, which will be essential if such a boater has insurance cover for public liability.

The number should be displayed anywhere on the deck of the boat and should not be obscured by other decals and / or number plates.

RSA 001

- Number and word digits to be minimum 25mm high, 20mm wide and 5mm thick with a 20mm spacing between the RSA and the number.
- No italic font please.
- Number to be black or white depending on the boat background colour.
- Number could be stuck directly onto the boat and a specific background colour is not specified.
